



Red Dot

Charlotte County has a wonderful program to help you in the case of a medical emergency. It's called the red dot program because it started with people putting a red dot on their refrigerator to notify EMT's that their medical information was on file with the county. The 911 system will now have that information, but some documents should still be on the fridge for their use. The first step is filling out the form supplied by the county. We have some copies in the church office, or you can go to the Sheriff's office on Willmington Blvd to get a form. Information on where to send the form is available on the sheet.



Romans 5:8 "But God proves his own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

These words from Paul to the Church should focus our attention as we move through March, the Lenten season, Holy Week and the Easter Celebration.

All that this month holds, including the celebration of St Patrick's Day, draws us to the depth of God's love for us. Walking through our 40 days of Lent, we recall Jesus' 40 days in the wilderness, and Israel's 40 years in in the wildness. Led by God, Israel, Jesus, and we today, experience the love and faithfulness of Emmanuel, God with us.

Holy week invites us to walk with Jesus from the Palm Sunday triumphal entry into Jerusalem to the via Dolorosa (sorrowful way) as Jesus leaves the city to be hung on a cross for the sins of the world. Moving from joy as Jesus is hailed as king, palm branches and cloaks strewn in his path, to the shouts of "crucify him" as he is marched out of the city with a crown of thorns on his head, to be enthroned on an instrument of suffering and death.

The depth of God's love is not spoken in words, but in actions. God's leading through a pillar of cloud by day and fire by night in the wilderness. God sending angels to minister to Jesus in the wilderness. God with us in times of trial, suffering, guilt, shame, and infirmity, these are demonstrations of God's love for us.

While we were still sinner's, Christ died for us. God does not wait for us to be worthy of our salvation, make enough confession, or show true repentance and amendment of our lives. God just loves us, and Jesus gives his life for us, to prove that love. If we learn one lesson in this season, it should be along the lines of God's unconditional love. And it is that love that we respond to as we live our lives in love toward others.

If I leave you to ponder these things, it is designed to invite you to join us for worship on Wednesday evenings in Lent, at 5:00 for soup and 6:00 for worship.

On Good Friday you should receive the April newsletter where we can hear and be encouraged by "the rest of the story." Until then, hear about, see and experience the love of God as we journey with Jesus through these 40 days.
